# San José Neighborhood Cmsn report from Work Plan ad hoc Cmte

#### Purpose of Work Plan

- Defines what we want to do and when to do it
- Assures that we do what needs to be done, and that we allow time to do it.
- Just a "guide":
  - Schedules may shift to accommodate others,
  - Topics may be added or dropped according to events
- Plan for just the 10 sessions this year
  - Don't take too long planning: want to leave time for doing
    - Last year, took 6 meetings to plan...
  - Don't plan for too much leave time for future add-ins

#### Process

- Collect ideas
  - Council's top-10, NC round-table (6/15 mtg), public input, left-overs from last year's NC list
  - "Must do's" no choice; need to allow them time
- Ad hoc cmte reviewed the combined list
  - Sorted by size, category, uniqueness & usefulness
  - Sorted by interest and willingness to work or lead
- Tonight:
  - Hear from Cmsnrs & public add more to list?
  - Volunteer to work or lead?
  - Select tasks for 2015-16 & fold into year's calendar

#### Task Characterization (1)

- Within NC's charter?
- Leverage? Help other projects, other Cmsns?
- Communities impacted?
  - Citywide? Diverse? In need of assistance?
- Level of effort?
  - Small: Just request a report/presentation? 1/2 hr?
  - Med: Discussion & decision; letter? 1/2 session?
  - Large: Special / multiple sessions? Public outreach?
    - Is there a Champion on NC to shepherd the process?


#### Task Characterization (2)

- Categories:
  - Code Enforcement (CEnf);
  - Public Safety (PubS);
  - Transportation (Trnsp);
  - Community Engagement (CEng); and
  - Budget (Bdgt);
  - plus "housekeeping" (HK -- take care of Cmsn business)
- Don't <u>have</u> to do one from each category, don't want to do only from one or two...

## The "Mandatory Topics"

- Revisit the process for Caucus election in Nov.;
   establish protocols, a small (HK) task in November,
- Actually do the caucuses, a medium (HK) task in May (doesn't take time away from mtgs),
- Review Mayor's budget proposal and give feedback:
   a large (Bdgt) task spanning Feb April, and
- Propose the 2016-17 Work Plan: a large (HK) task in June

## Recommended by ad hoc Committee

- Policies on Police Body Cameras
  - a large (PubS) task
- Develop process for community input
  - medium, (CEng);
- Illegal dumping and blight prevention
  - a small task (request a report) (CEnf), and
- Refine and document the process by which NC develops a work product, a medium (HK) task.

#### "Subtotal"

- These 8 tasks are comprised of 3 large tasks and 3 medium ones: that should keep us fairly busy.
- They span most of the categories:
  - Budget (Bdgt), Code Enforcement (CEnf), Community Engagement (CEng), and Public Safety (PubS), along with Housekeeping (HK)
- 3 of the 8 tasks are "internal": caucus, work plan, and defining the NC workflow
- Do we want to do more?


#### Add More Tasks to Work Plan?

- Have room to add a number of "small" tasks
  - Just requesting a Staff presentation can indicate the NC's interest in the topic, can spur effort by Staff, and can provide information for NC to share w/ community
- Might want to add some "medium" tasks
  - Possible if there is additional Cmsnr participation
  - Topic would be worked on by ad hoc subcmte, which then briefs the full NC w/ progress reports and final recommendations

## **Suggested Additional Topics**

- Budget/rezoning, incentive review: medium (Bdgt);
- Graffiti abatement: a small task (CEnf);
- Crowd-sourcing of private surveillance camera data: a small task (PubS);
- Invite the City Auditor to attend and provide comment: a small task (CEng);
- Council's Outreach Policy 6-30 & how it's being implemented: medium (CEng);
- Outside Agency Policies (e.g, VTA, SCVWD) in SJ: medium (CEng); and
- the Illegal Fireworks Ordinance: a small task (PubS)
- Staff reco.: report on "Vision Zero": small (Trnsp).

  - Track changes in Envision 2040 update (CEng);
  - Policy to Allow 2nd'ry Units (CEnf); and
  - Traffic calming (Trnsp)
- Medium task: would need volunteers to commit
  - Permit Parking (CEnf)
  - ["Data-driven decision process" combined w/ "NC work process"]

#### **Commission Duties**

- The Neighborhoods Commission shall integrate the voice of neighborhoods into the City's decision-making processes; study issues, courses of action, policies, and programs that affect neighborhood quality of life; make recommendations to council and redevelopment agency; and empower neighborhoods. The commission will make regular reports to the San José City Council, City staff, and neighborhood groups. The Neighborhoods Commission work plan will be developed in coordination with, and approved by, the Neighborhood Services and Education Committee. Annual reports will be provided by commissioners at the yearly Neighborhood Caucus by council district.
- The Neighborhoods Commission is advisory to the City Council regarding San José neighborhoods. The Commission would work with both City and, when applicable, Redevelopment Agency staff, and when appropriate, collaborate with other commissions and boards.
- All neighborhood caucuses will be held between August 18, 2010 and September
   25, 2010

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## San José Neighborhood Cmsn Thoughts on Work Flow


#### Communications

- Need an Official NC website
  - post the materials presented to the NC
    - so that Cmsnrs can review and share w/ public
    - preferably, x days in advance (except for rush/emergency cases)
    - within x days after presentation
  - Archive of NC letters and reports
  - Link to audio recordings of NC mtgs
- Use of Unofficial website & Social Media
  - for communication w/ Cmsnrs' home district
  - implications of Brown Act?


## How to Agendize a Topic

- Automatically from approved Work Plan
- by Commissioner at the preceding mtg or email
  - at least 2 weeks prior, to Staff & Chair
- by Staff in the CMO
  - often at request of City Dept.
  - NC willing to "focus group" consult, but not willing to be a "community input" "box checked".
- Staff and Chair consult about a week prior to meeting to finalize agenda
  - Staff posts to website, as per Brown Act reqmnts.


## **Types of Nghbrhd Cmsn Involvement**






